

## Getting Your Bearings

We've been blessed with a large campus, and at first it can be a bit confusing getting around. In the map below, we've noted 5 structures, as follows:

### 1. Sanctuary

The sanctuary is the center of life at Soest. This structure, built in 1908, is where we meet weekly for worship services. The **balcony** hosts the organ and choir and provides additional seating. It can be accessed by the stairs on the south end of the narthex. The **narthex** is the entrance area between the main exterior doors and the sanctuary.

### 2. Christian Growth Center (CGC)

The Christian Growth Center is connected to the Sanctuary by a hallway on the north end of the narthex. This addition, built in 1993, is home to the **Fellowship Hall**, the **Bible Class** room, the **Nursery**, the restrooms, and the basement. The basement is used on Sundays for Sunday School and through the week for the daycare.

### 3. School

Across Emanuel Rd from the church is our school. Grades PreK-3 through 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade have classrooms here. In the basement is a kitchen and lunchroom.

### 4. Family Life Center (FLC)

The Family Life Center was built in 2005, and houses the **Church Office** and **Pastor's Office**, a kitchen and meeting area, a large **gym** floor, and the youth **loft**.

### 5. Teacherage

The teacherage house is located on Wayne Trace and often used to house church workers.
